

## MAX TO LAUNCH 3 MULTI-SPECIALTY HOSPITALS IN NORTH INDIA

Max Healthcare is building three new multi-specialty hospitals in north India with a total investment of ₹300 crore which would be operational by September. These three hospitals are coming up at Dehradun in Uttarakhand, Mohali in Haryana and Bhatinda in Punjab, Max Healthcare Executive Director Dilpreet Brar said. The 200 bedded hospital in Dehradun, which is being built with an investment of ₹100 crore, is spread over an area of four acres and offer high-end medical expertise with superior patient care services. "This hospital is in line with our strategic objective to expand our reach and provide quality healthcare access in North India," she said. The hospital will provide health facilities in cardiac, neuroscience, orthopaedics, obstetrics and gynaecology, internal medicine, general surgery, mental healthcare and behavioural sciences among others, she said. The other two hospitals in Mohali and Bhatinda will also provide similar features apart from having an oncology department. Max Healthcare currently operates eight hospitals in Delhi and NCR and has a staff base of over 1,250 doctors.
