

## Max Healthcare overhauls brass

New Delhi, Oct 31: Max Healthcare, one of the largest corporate hospital chains of the country on Monday rejigged its leadership team by putting in place a new chief executive officer, chief operating officer and a chief services officer.

Accordingly, Ajay Bakshi, a 43 year old neurosurgeon who has been working as an associate partner with McKinsey for last six years takes charge as the CEO of the healthcare firm this week. Another medico Abha Agrawal, currently working as the chief medical officer at a 700 bedded tertiary hospital in New York is set to join Max this December as COO, Ranvir Bhandari, the present executive chairman of Max ventures, another holding

company of parent group Max India that deals in hospitality would take on the additional responsibility of chief services officer in the healthcare company while continuing in his former role in the group. With this, Max has completed the restructuring process of its top management. "While we refilled the post of CEO, we recreated the position of COO and innovated as far as the post of chief services officer is considered," said Rahul Khosla, MD, Max India.

Khosla who co-headed a taskforce with the promoter of the corporate group, Analjit Singh made the new recruitments after a series of consultation with internal stakeholders as well as outside partners which work with the hospital group on a regular basis, he said.
