Dr. Inderjit Singh Virdi has done his M.Ch in Cardiothoracic Surgery from PGIMER, Chandigarh. He received further training in adult and paediatric cardiac surgery from the Wessex Cardiothoracic Centre in Southampton, U.K. He received his fellowship In Cardiothoracic surgery from Royal college of surgeons in May 1993. He then proceeded to Australia for further training in heart and lung transplant at St. Vincent's Hospital, Sydney. He received his fellowship in Cardiothoracic surgery from Royal Australasian College in November 2000.

After his extensive overseas experience, he returned to work at Indraprastha Apollo Hospital, New Delhi as a Senior Consultant. Before joining Max Healthcare, Dr. Virdi was working as a Senior Consultant and

was an Associate Professor at James Cook University, Australia. His areas of expertise are Heart and Lung transplantation, Coronary artery disease, Mitral valve repair, Arrhythmia surgery for atrial fibrillation, surgical procedures for Aortic aneurysms dissections and Lung cancer surgery. He has conducted more than 5000 Heart and Lung operations of all types.

Dr. Viridi is currently involved in research on myocardial preservation and has many research papers to his credit.
